UNITED FOOD BANK FOOD and FUNDS DRIVE GUIDELINES

Thank you for hosting a food and funds drive for United Food Bank. Below are some guidelines to help you be successful in collecting food and funds to help your Arizona neighbors fight hunger.

- 1. Monetary donations are very welcome and can be put toward United Food Bank's awesome purchasing power. United Food Bank purchases food from large food distributors in large quantities. \$1 can purchase \$9 worth of food.
- 2. Consider providing your own transportation. Gas prices and transportation costs incurred by United Food Bank diminishes your overall donation. Should you not be able to provide transportation, United Food Bank will be happy to drop off your food drive supplies (food drive boxes and colorful food drive posters) and pick up the donations.
- 3. See our "Success Suggestions" for ideas to engage your employees or your potential donors.
- 4. United Food Bank will issue to you a Donation Order Form. Please present this form to our driver or warehouse personnel when your food is picked up or delivered to United Food Bank. This will ensure that you are properly thanked for the number of pounds of food collected during your food drive.
- 5. Please make an effort to return unused food drive supplies to the United Food Bank. Every penny we save means more food to hungry neighbors.
- 6. Non-perishable items only, please. No glass containters.
- 7. Please allow United Food Bank 48 hours to schedule a supply drop-off or a food pick-up. We mobilize many trucks each day which requires planning.
