WE DISTRIBUTED MORE THAN 18 MILLION MUCH-NEEDED MEALS

Your generosity ensured we were able to meet the increased needs of children, families, and seniors across the community! You helped get food into the hands of those who need it most.



WE FED THOUSANDS OF FOOD INSECURE CHILDREN AND FAMILIES

Approximately 1 in 7 youth in Arizona, or 226,080 kids, are food insecure. As the cost of everything has risen, many parents are unable to keep enough food in their homes. But you've given growing kids the nutritious food they need during this difficult time.



WE PROVIDED 6.3 MILLION POUNDS OF FRESH PRODUCE
